#### **DSGA Board Meeting Minutes**

April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016 By Martha Carpenter

Attendees: Jack and Cynthia Rigsby, Mark and Patty Franklin, Larry Sherrill, Pam Haffner, Pat and Bruce Kovach, Martha and Claude Carpenter, Jessie Worsham, and Mike and Dorothy Warren

Vice President Mark Franklin called the meeting to order (Cynthia Rigsby was delayed because of traffic accident on Georgia 400). The previous minutes were accepted by unanimous vote.

Pam Haffner discussed potential Education Corner topics for the April 16 meeting. It was decided that there would be a presentation on companion plants plus a short overview of the duties of show clerks.

Mark stated that our speaker for the April 16 meeting would be Heather Herrington. Mark will drive to Macon that morning to pick up Heather. Heather will bring 10 of her daylily introductions for auction at the meeting.

Larry Sherrill discussed the upcoming plant sales:

April 8-9 Forsyth County Master Gardener's Sale in Cumming. People will be needed to help dig, divide and label at the following location: Wednesday April 6 at the home of Barbara and Herb Metz, Thursday April 6 at the home of Bruce and Pat Kovach, and Thursday April 6 at the home of Patty and Mark Franklin. We will need at least 300 double fans for the sale.

<u>April 30 North Fulton Master Gardener's Sale in Roswell</u>. Volunteers for digging, dividing and labeling will be obtained during our April 16 meeting.

We will need flyers at the plant sales advertising our show on June 11.

Patty Franklin gave an overview of our upcoming Daylily Show on June 11at the Old Atlanta Recreation facility. Setup will be from 3-5 pm on Friday June 10. Volunteers will be needed to help setup the tables and arrange the room. There is a shortage of approximately 10 tables at the Old Atlanta Recreation facility. The facility is looking for additional tables from other Forsyth County facilities. It was noted that anyone can enter daylilies in the show; however, you must be a member of the AHS to win a Rosette. Jack and Cynthia Rigsby picked up approximately 300 wine bottles from Bill Waldrop and these will be used in our show.

Mark Franklin will call hybridizer Pete Harry to have him ship our 2016 MAPS plants. Mark will grow the daylilies in his garden and they will be available during our MAPS auction in September.

At this point President Cynthia Rigsby arrived and took over as moderator of the meeting. She then asked for the treasurer's report. Jack presented the report and there is a balance of \$16,006.91 in our bank account. The report was approved by a unanimous vote.

Cynthia gave the following report from March 5th Region 5 Meeting in Macon, Georgia:

"Scott Elliott, Region 5 President, is asking members to suggest what kind of programs and topics for speakers they would like to see in future meetings. He also said they would like for 2 or 3 clubs to sell bargain plants at the October meeting. The region would get 50% of the profits."

There was a general discussion on Scott's suggestions. The general consensus was that we would like to have at least a year's notice to enable us to grow plants for the sale and that we would not be able to do it this year.

There was also a discussion about our club hosting the 2018 Region 5 Spring Meeting. Cynthia will present it to the club for a vote during our April 16 general meeting.

Cynthia reported that the 2016 Region 5 Spring Meeting is May 27-28 in Statesboro, Georgia. The 95 attendee limit is still not met. Cynthia also reported that there are only a few slots still available for the AHS National Convention in Louisville.

Based on previous commitment to send \$5 to the region for each DSGA member, Jack will send \$105 to Region 5 to support the Georgia Daylily.

We discussed the club taking a bus trip to Ohio in 2017. Bruce is the chairman of the bus trip and will report trip details at a future Board Meeting.

The meeting was adjourned.


