DSGA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

October 25th, 2015

Attendees: Barbara Metz, Herb Metz, Felicity O'Neal, Larry Sherrill, Janet Sherrill, Virgil Herndon, Carolyn Herndon, Jack Rigsby, Cynthia Rigsby, Angie Tatum, Shirley Lesiuk, Mike Warren, Claude Carpenter, Martha Carpenter, Pat Kovach, Bruce Kovach, Jessie Worsham, Patty Franklin, Mark Franklin, Pam Haffner, Palmer Haffner and guests: Rita Buehner and Katielou Greene from the Cobb County Daylily Society.

President Patty Franklin called the meeting to order by thanking both the new board members and the retiring board members for attending. The previous minutes were accepted by a unanimous voice vote; following a motion to approve by Jack and a second by Virgil. Angie then reviewed the Treasurer's Report. The balance as of August 30, 2015 is \$17, 667.09. The Treasurer's Report was accepted by a unanimous voice vote; following a motion to approve by Jack and a second by Mark.

Per our tax-exempt status, and required by the IRS, an audit of our treasurer's books was conducted by Palmer Haffner and Janet Sherrill prior to this Board meeting. All was found to be in accordance with the financial policies.

OLD BUSINESS:

A report was made by Patty, Virgil and Claude regarding the possible sites for the 2016 Show.

Virgil and Claude gave us the information on the Roswell Adult Recreation Center. The fee would be \$1825. That includes the site, parking, the tables, set up and clean up. We would need to provide lunch and there would be a charge for use of the kitchen. This site would be central to both clubs.

Fowler Park (Forsyth County) is available (sign up beginning January 1, 2016) for a \$300. fee. There is no place there for the luncheon. It was noted the Reed Barn is very near by the Park. The space and the parking are good. We would need to supply extra tables.

Lanier Tech (Forsyth County) is a 4 star location! And the fee is \$1850.

Patty reported the Cumberland Mall has no interest in hosting, the Perimeter Mall will be renovating next year and North Point Mall is interested and would charge us \$3300 for one day!

Patty then asked our guests what sites the Cobb Club had investigated. At this time they are waiting for our club to decide if we wanted to do a joint show and their only site is the Marietta First United Methodist Church. The price was thought to be \$600. They weren't sure what that fee might include.

A discussion was held regarding whether or not DSGA would host our own show or continue on with a joint show with the Cobb Club. The Cobb Club president, Steven Verner asked the representatives to convey his wish to continue on as a joint show. Following this discussion, the Cobb representatives will present the information to their club for a vote.

After more discussion regarding: costs, judges, catering, rental, location, etc. The key consideration of the discussion was whether we want an individual club show or a combined show.

DSGA will also present the information to the entire club at the November 14th general meeting and a vote will be taken.

Patty then asked Larry and Palmer to give a summary of the Duluth Days Sale. Considering the rainy Saturday, the club still made \$2047.42. We had decided not to discount any daylilies (many were plants from the convention) and the leftovers are currently residing at the Metz's until the Spring sales.

The topic of a bus trip in 2016 was discussed. Bruce had looked at the dates for the Northern Mecca (Ohio) and it comes just one week before the National Weekend in KY --- the first weekend in July. Patty suggested more discussion for locations and specifics to take place later. She did agree it would be a great idea to use the National funds to reward the club for all of the hard work.

Patty asked Claude Carpenter for an update on Region 5 activities. Claude has retired from the Presidency of Region 5 and Scott Elliot is now the President. If you are interested in going, you will need to pre-register using a form that was in The Georgia Daylily or on the club's website. Patty thanked Claude for his service.

Claude also announced the Region 5 Meeting will be May 27-28 in Statesboro. Registration will be limited to 96 and you will need to register ASAP.

Patty introduced Cynthia as our new president and suggested a break before we continued.

Karen will need help moving pots of daylilies before her move. Several volunteered to help her on October 29th.

The 2016 calendar was reviewed. The Board meeting hosts for 2016 will be:

February-Haffners, April-Kovachs, August-Metzs, October-Carpenters and the Franklins will host the Popularity Poll Party/Plant Swap in August.

Because of the Convention this year, the Map Points period was extended from April 2014 to September 2015. It was decided to continue the Map tabulation from September 1, 2015 thru August 31, 2016.

Cynthia asked if someone would consider filling the Parliamentarian position. Jessie volunteered and a vote will be taken at the November General Meeting. Carolyn will fill the vacant Board member seat—following a vote at the General meeting.

Barbara volunteered to fill the Sunshine position, Felicity will continue as Club Reporter and Pam will continue as the Map Chairman and the Education Corner chairman. Palmer will not continue on as co-chair of the Plant Sale Committee. Cynthia asked for volunteers to serve with Larry in 2016. We will ask the general membership.

If we do a separate show in 2016, Claude will be the co-chair.

Mark, as Vice President will be scheduling the Programs for 2016. He listed those hybridizers he had contacted and asked if we had suggestions. Then we persuaded Claude to do a photography program at the November general meeting. He will present photography tips and suggestions for displaying your photographs.

Claude suggested we need a new projector that is compatible with our new computer for the programs. Angie made a motion for Claude to purchase a projector (in the \$400 - \$500 range) and Virgil seconded it. The vote was unanimous.

We will continue to bring Door Prizes (including the brownie pan) to the general meetings.

Other business:

Our Christmas Party will be December 12th at Bellemere and we will have a \$15 gift exchange. It was mentioned there will be a Christmas tour of Bellemere and Carolyn will let us know the dates and ticket information.

Patty invited us for a one day trip to her Dad's home in Hiawassee in April. The Rhododendrons should be beautiful. We will schedule this in the new year.

Claude made a motion to adjourn. Patty seconded the motion. Another unanimous vote.


