



DSGA BOARD MEETING MINUTES August 30, 2015

Attendees: Pam Haffner, Palmer Haffner, Patty Franklin, Mark Franklin, Barbara Metz, Herb Metz, Felicity O'Neal, Larry Sherrill, Virgil Herndon, Jack Rigsby, Angie Tatum, Shirley Lesiuk, Claude Carpenter, Karen Mowry and guests: Pat Kovach, Bruce Kovach, Carolyn Herndon, Janet Sherrill and Cynthia Rigsby.

President Patty Franklin called the meeting to order by thanking the Haffners for hosting the group in their home. The previous Minutes were accepted and Angie reviewed the Treasurer's Report. The balance as of August 30, 2015 is \$17, 073.06. The Treasurer's Report was accepted.

Patty then informed the Board that there were 3,000 plant labels left over from the AHS Convention which the Board unanimously agreed to use for plant sales until the supply is exhausted, saving the club the cost of ordering any more for approximately one year.

Results were then shared about the AHS National Convention which we hosted along with CCDS in June. Rave reviews were received and the gardens were said to have been some of the best ever viewed. Our garden owners worked for more than two years in preparation, as well as all of the organizing committees. Kudos are given to everyone who participated in any way for a job very well done. At that time, the Convention Treasurer, Jack Rigsby, distributed a finalized Financial Report from the convention, which is available for any member's viewing through any Board member. As a result of the convention, our club balance has increased significantly.

Claude Carpenter then updated us on Region 5 activities. The next meeting will be on Sat., Oct. 3 in Macon and Pete Harry will be the speaker. As usual, there will be a bargain table of daylilies for sale. If you are interested in going, you may pre-register using a form that was in The Georgia Daylily or on the club's website. Claude also announced that his term as President has ended and the new President will be Scott Elliott. We thank both of these gentlemen for their dedication and service.

The Board voted to make a \$250 donation to the AHS in memory of Lillian Grovenstein, who gave many years of service to DSGA and Region 5. Our sympathies go to her husband, Erling and family.

Patty then thanked the Board Members whose terms were ending soon and Pam Haffner, Chair of the Nominating Committee, presented the slate for new officers to be voted on by the General Membership on September 19th. There is one position still open, that of Parliamentarian, so please consider if you might be willing to accept that duty and call Pam Haffner, please.

Patty then announced that there is a change of location for the next DSGA Board meeting. It will be held at 2 p.m. at the Franklin's home.

The President then presented a proposition from DSGA member, David Healy, for us to adopt an area outside the front of the YMCA building in Alpharetta. We have many new high-quality seedlings that were donated by hybridizers for the convention and can use them for the planting beds. We will be able to receive great exposure for our club with the addition of a sign denoting DSGA as having donated the plants. David said that he will maintain these daylily beds. The Board approved this proposal with a stipulation that the dollar amount spent should not exceed \$250.

Our next topic was our biggest sale of the year, the Duluth Days Plant Sale. Palmer Haffner will soon be emailing members asking for your division donations and for help working either the tent sale or at the gardens digging, dividing and labeling beforehand. This is our last sale of the year and we very much appreciate member's assistance in any manner. As a business matter, the outgoing Treasurer will inform the various sales of the contact information of the incoming Treasurer. The sale will have double fans available at prices of \$5 per double fan to \$20 (relating to years of introductions and popularity). We will have handouts about the club and about daylilies for the general public. Claude pointed out how very important it is to have a great picture and description of the plants as it is hard to sell without that information.

The Board then reviewed the plan for the MAP points auction and sale to be held at the next General Meeting on September 19. We will have wonderful plants this year and hope all members will tally their points soon (as per your recent email from Pam Haffner) and enjoy using your hard-earned MAP points to pick up some very special plants for your garden. At the conclusion of the auction, we will open some bargain tables where you can also use your points (or any left-over points after auction) for "purchase".

About a week before the auction, everyone will receive a list of the plants being auctioned from Claude Carpenter, who has graciously offered to prepare for the membership.

As mentioned in previous Minutes, it will be cost-prohibitive for us to continue having our joint daylily show with CCDS at the Cobb Galleria. Several possible locations were discussed and a committee was formed to check out the various possibilities. The committee of Jack Rigsby, Claude Carpenter and Virgil Herndon will research ASAP as we will need to get the date reserved. Patty Franklin will also help by checking Perimeter Mall and North Point Mall. The main point of discussion was whether we want an individual club show or a joint show. This point will be basically decided by the location and whether or not CCDS is in agreement with the new venue.

Patty then presented the proposed 2016 Calendar of Events and also suggested that each outgoing President do the same for the year following their Presidency because reserving locations and dates may not be possible if not done early enough.

Additionally, the Board discussed a possible bus tour in Summer 2016 and will inform members with research results. It will need to be after our own daylily show but before the AHS Convention in Louisville.

According to our tax-exempt status, and demanded by the IRS, our group must have 3 non-officer members present a report of any issues of conflict of interest. That committee will consist of Carolyn Herndon, Palmer Haffner and Janet Sherrill and it will be conducted before the October Board Meeting.

Our September 19 General Meeting will have a slightly different format: we will begin promptly at 10 a.m. (so arrive a little early, please). The club will provide ham and members are asked to bring brunch food as we will eat upon arrival. Then, we will have our speaker's program who is the highly respected Tim Herrington. After Tim's program, we will have our business meeting and finally the MAP plant auction. After the auction, you can peruse the bargain table for more beautiful daylilies.

Duluth Fall Festival

September 26 and September 27



Dear DSGA Members,

As a reminder, the upcoming **Duluth Fall Festival** is scheduled for September 26th & 27th from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm on Saturday and 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Sunday. This is one of our best sale events of the year due to the large crowd. Many of our customers come looking for our booth year after year because of the quality and value of our plants. We will be setting up the Daylily booth about 7:30 am on Saturday with breakdown on Sunday around 5:00 pm. To be successful it requires the involvement of our members and we will have signup sheets to work the booth at our next club meeting on September 19th. so check your calendars and select your preferred hours to work.

If you have signed up to donate plants or have plants to donate, please trim, tag, provide a quality picture (You can copy and paste pictures from the AHS Database or allthingsplants.com), a short description and a suggested sale price. Contact Palmer Haffner (before the September Meeting and he will have them available) at 678 315-5111 should you need tags. The Board at it's last meeting set the sales prices to be between \$5.00 and \$20.00 with no discounts or giveaways at the end of the day. Because of the quality and expected volume of the plants any unsold plants will be re-planted and saved for the Forsyth County Master Gardener Sale in the spring of 2016. We have found that buyers are attracted to the pictures and those plants always sell first. So that we can be ready to sell at 9:00 am on the first day, receipt of the donated plants to Larry Sherrill or Palmer Haffner should be made either on Friday the 25th or before 9:00 am on the 26th (at the Festival).

Should you have old copies of your "The Georgia Daylily and or The Daylily Journal" that you no longer want, please bring those as well and we will sell those for a \$1.00 a copy. You would be surprised; they have sold well in the past.

Thank you to everyone in advance for making this a successful event for our club.


