DSGA Board Meeting Minutes

August 27, 2017

Attendees: Jack and Cynthia Rigsby, Mark and Patty Franklin, Larry Sherrill, Bruce & Pat Kovach, Martha and Claude Carpenter, Barbara and Herb Metz, Pam and Palmer Haffner, Dorothy and Mike Warren, Chuck Self

Cynthia called the meeting to order and thanked Dorothy and Mike Warren for being our hosts. The minutes of the general meeting on April 15, 2017 were approved. Jack Rigsby gave an overview of our financial situation. The current balance in our banking account is \$12,269.86. Jack reminded everyone that the club membership dues need to be paid by November 1 to enable him to send in AHS Membership dues to Pat Mercer prior to the end of the year. The financial report was approved.

Cynthia reviewed the proposed DSGA Schedule of Events for 2018. There were a few changes and the board meetings for 2018 will be hosted by the following:

- February 4 hosted by Pam and Palmer Haffner
- March 25 hosted by Pat and Bruce Kovach
- August 26 hosted by Mark and Patty Franklin
- October 28 hosted by Martha and Claude Carpenter

Claude Carpenter went over the plans for DSGA hosting the 2018 Region 5 Spring Meeting on June 15-16.

- The hotel (Hilton Garden Inn Atlanta North/Alpharetta located at 4025 Windward Plaza) has been reserved for the above dates. (Jack & Cynthia Rigsby and Mark & Patty Franklin and Claude Carpenter were the committee to select the hotel)
- Jack Rigsby will be the Treasurer for the meeting. Jack has developed a financial spreadsheet for the meeting and stated that we will need to charge a registration fee of \$110.
- The registration fee will include dinner at the hotel on Friday and Saturday nights.
- The host gardens will be the gardens of Mark and Patty Franklin, Pat and Bruce Kovach, and Claude and Martha Carpenter. The host garden owners will be given \$100 to cover refreshment expenses. It is estimated that attendees will spend at least 45 minutes in each garden during the tour.
- Harold McDonnel has contracted with Buckhead Coach for buses to carry our guests to the tour gardens. Two busses will be used. The cost is \$2,461.00.

Patty Franklin has developed a Registration Form for the meeting. Information about the meeting and the Registration Form will be handed out at the AHS Region 5 fall meeting and will be posted on the DSGA and Region 5 websites.

Information and the Registration form will be emailed to all AHS members in Region 5.

- Bus captains and navigators for each bus will be determined later.
- Bruce Kovach and Chuck Self will be in charge of soliciting auction plants from hybridizers for our auction. We plan to have approximately 100 plants.
- Mark Franklin and Bruce Kovach will donate the registration plants.
- We plan to have Region 5 clubs donate items for a silent auction. (It was decided not to have clubs donate baskets this time since the response was not real good for the meeting in Valdosta this year)
- Our Guest Speaker for the meeting will be Julie Covington from Virginia. Julie is a former AHS President.
- The Hybridizers bed is located in the Garden of Pat and Bruce Kovach.
- Joann Stewart will be asked to plan Exhibition Judges Clinics at the meeting.
- James Fennell will be asked to plan Garden Judges Clinics for the meeting.

Patty Franklin then discussed the possibility of conducting a Show in 2018. After a short discussion it was decided that we will have an off Scape exhibition (Not judged) on June 23rd. We may also ask our attendees to vote on their favorite off Scape bloom. We will also have a plant sale.

Cynthia then asked Pam Haffner to present the nominating committee's nominations for 2018 Officers and Board members. The nominating committee members are Pam Haffner, Dorothy Warren, and Virgil Herndon. Their nominations are:

Cynthia went over how the new membership dues will be handled. For members who already have a multi-year membership in AHS or have Lifetime membership in AHS there will be no membership fee. For all others the fee will be the current price of AHS membership and will be due by November 1 each year. For members that belong to other clubs, DSGA will only pay for their AHS membership if DSGA is their primary club.

Jack Rigsby asked that each member turn in to him there MAPS points prior to the September meeting since that will help him when collecting money from the auction. MAPS plants are coming from Blue Ridge Nursery. New members (joined during the past year or joining at the meeting) will have special pricing for plants on the Bargain Table.

Mark Franklin discussed how we will provide plants for the bargain table at the AHS Region 5 Fall meeting in Macon. We will buy plants from Blue Ridge Nursery and augment with some that will be donated by DSGA members.

Cynthia reminded us of upcoming events:

- September 23-24 The Duluth Fall Festival. Mark asked for assistance to dig and clean plants on September 20th and 21st.
- September 16 MAPS Auction, Bargain Table. Claude will give an overview of the upcoming 2018 Region 5 Spring Meeting during the Education Corner time at the beginning of the meeting.

Membership Dues Reminder

Annual Dues – This is a reminder that we will start collecting 2018 membership dues at the September General Meeting. Jack acquired from Pat Mercer, AHS Executive Secretary, a listing of all Region 5 AHS Members. The list provided the AHS membership expiration date for each member on the list. Jack will have a name list of those DSGA members whose AHS membership expires in December 2017. These members will need to pay their dues no later than December 1, 2017 for 2018. Those DSGA members who have AHS membership expiration dates beyond December 2017 will not have to pay dues for 2018. Their dues will be due December 1st of their expiration year i.e., expiration date December 2018, dues for 2019, due on December 1, 2018. The individual membership will be \$25 per year. Membership of Two adults at one address will be \$30 per year. Youth membership is \$10 per year. In the future, request that all DSGA members submit their membership dues to the Treasurer. Jack will submit to Pat Mercer a listing of DSGA AHS membership renewals for 2018. The listing and a check for payment of their AHS membership dues will be submitted on or before 12-31-17. DSGA General Meeting Minutes April 15, 2016

Attendees: 22 Members and guests were present. Our guests were Jennifer McBreyer and Oliver Shackleford.

Pam Haffner started our meeting with the Education Corner. Her topic was Companion Plants. Pam discussed a number of plants that complement the daylilies in our gardens. She also had a handout with a list of recommended companion plants.

Cynthia identified member that have medical issues. Janet Sherrill had hip surgery and is recovering at home. Bill Waldrop is doing well after his heart surgery. Dennis Calbreath will need another surgery.

This was followed by a wonderful brunch prepared by our members.

Cynthia Rigsby called the business meeting to order.

She asked for the acceptance of the minutes of the April 2, 2017 DSGA board meeting that was published in the DSGA newsletter and sent to all members. The minutes were unanimously accepted by the members present.

Jack Rigsby gave the Financial Report. Sales at our Forsyth County Master Gardener's plant sale for approximately \$1000. As of the meeting the balance in our bank account was \$19,920.19. The Financial Report was unanimously accepted by the members present.

Cynthia read a letter from Dean Day Smith thanking us for the \$300 contribution to the Georgia Garden Club Scholarship Fund in her honor.

Mark Franklin presented a proposed amendment to the DSGA By-Laws Article IX as follows;

Section 1. Annual dues are payable in advance by December 1 of each year.

Section 2. There shall be three types of annual dues:

- a). Individual Membership: \$25 per year.
- b). Membership of Two Adults at One Address: \$30.00 per year.
- c). Youth Membership: \$10.00 per year.

Section 3. Dues shall be paid on an annual basis; however, members who join during or after the annual flower show shall have their dues credited to the following year.

Section 4. All collected annual dues shall be used to pay for each individual's membership or membership for two adults at one address or youth membership in the American Hemerocallis Society.

Section 5. The Treasurer shall pay annual renewal fees to the American Hemerocallis Society by December 31 of each year.

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(General meeting minutes continued...)

Section 6. In the event that the American Hemerocallis Society changes their annual dues, the club dues will change to reflect this increase.

Section 7. This amendment will take effect November 1, 2017.

The motion was made and seconded and after a short discussion was passed unanimous vote.

Bruce Kovach gave an overview of our planned bus trip to Northern Mecca in Ohio on July 6-9, 2017. We currently have 30 people signed up to go on the trip and we have room on the bus for a total of 50. We will visit 5 gardens in Ohio and possibly one or more on the way up and back.

We will have scape grooming and design clinics at the home of Pat and Bruce Kovach on May 13. Claude Carpenter will conduct the scape grooming clinic and Betty Williams will also the Design Clinic.

Cynthia appointed a nominating committee of three people to present recommendations for new officers and board members at the September Meeting. The new officers will be installed in the November Meeting. The Nominating Committee is composed of the following members:

Pam Haffner Dorothy Warren Virgil Herndon

Cynthia stated that signup sheets were available for people to sign-up for helping dig daylilies at the Kovach's on April 26 and to help during the North Fulton Master Gardener's Plant Sale in Roswell on April 29.

Cynthia also stated that we need items for the basket that our club will donated to the Valdosta Daylily Club for raffle during the Region 5 Spring Meeting in May 19-20.

Cynthia also stated that Virgil Herndon had a signup sheet for those that wanted to purchase logo shirts. Price for each shirt is \$20.

The Business Meeting was adjourned and was followed by a great presentation from Eric Simpson of Blue Ridge Daylilies. Eric also auctioned a number of his beautiful introductions.


