## **DSGA Board Meeting Minutes February 3, 2019**

Attendees: Palmer Haffner, Jack Rigsby, Harold McDonell, Chuck Self, Virgil Herndon, Pam Haffner, Patty Franklin, Carolyn Herndon, Mark Franklin, Bill Surls, Cynthia Rigsby

The meeting was called to order by president Mark Franklin. He thanked Pam and Palmer for hosting the meeting and welcomed everyone.

The minutes of the last board meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter.

Jack Rigsby, treasurer, gave his report stating that there had not been much activity since our last meeting. He handed out and explained the Cash Receipts/ Disbursements report for the period of 8-26-18 thru 1-31-19. There was a motion and second to accept the financial report; it was accepted.

Mark received a letter from the Garden Club of Georgia thanking DSGA for the \$500.00 donation in honor of Dean Day Sanders for her generosity in letting DSGA use the Bellmere Garden House for our meetings. A letter has been sent to Ms. Sanders in reference to this donation.

Under Old Business, Mark announced that the Daylily Education for the next meeting will be "Time to get your tools ready."

Mark related that there is no Plant Sales Chairman, and said that we need people to chair each sale individually. The club also needs plant donations from its members for each sale. Those donating plants must have the names of the plants they are donating to Chuck Self so that he can have photos made. He needs them by the Monday before each sale. If someone brings plants to a sale without letting Chuck know the names, they will be responsible for making a borderless 4x4 picture to accompany each different donation made. There was discussion about how to participate in plant sales. Patty Franklin said she would set up rules for workers to follow at each sale.

Mark said that everyone needs to have a nametag when they come to the meetings. New name tags should be made for anyone without one. When a member joins, the treasurer needs to notify the membership chairman who will get a name tag made before the next meeting.

Mark passed out copies of the new revised 2019 calendar. He pointed out the speakers for this year would be the Bishops on April 7; Show Awards and Maps Auction on September 14; and Lonnie and Glen Ward from "Oak Haven Farm." Our February meeting will be a program entitled "You Can Hyberdize Too."

Under New Business, Patty talked about the DSGA Daylily Show. She went over the categories to be included in the show. There will be an on-scape category which will be judged by AHS Exhibition judges; an off-scape category judged by the public; a photo contest judged by the public; and possibly a Design category judged by the public. Patty wants the majority of the participants in the Design category to be from our club. She will ask for commitments to do a design at the next meeting to determine the interest. There was a suggestion made that if we have Design categories that we get black tablecloths. Patty will contact the center to sign up for this event on February 15 which is the earliest date to do so.

The Region 5 Photo Contest has been set up by our club as a memorial to one of our former members, Dennis Calbreath. Judges for this contest will consist of 3 people: one professional photographer chosen by the chairman of the Region 5 photo contest; one member from the DSGA club; one AHS member chosen by the chairman of the Region 5 photo contest. The club needs to name a representative, and the other AHS position will be offered to the membership.

Pam Haffner reported that she had not selected anyone from whom to purchase our MAPS Auction plants. After a short discussion, the board decided on Eric Simpson from Blue Ridge Daylilies. The board agreed to offer \$1,000.00 for daylily auction plants from Simpson. The president mentioned the possibility of our club taking a trip to North Carolina in the future.

There was a short discussion about how important it is to keep our website updated and accurate. Mark encouraged everyone to give updates for Claude to post on our website.

Our Hospitality Chair, Martha Carpenter, suggested to Mark that we have a chili lunch for the February meeting. Four board members volunteered to make a crock pot of chili: Chuck Self, Carolyn Herndon, Cynthia Rigsby, and Palmer Haffner. Patty volunteered to bake potatoes. Salads, fruit, and desserts will be provided by members. We are planning for 40 people.

Mark said it was time to nominate a nominating committee for next years officers and board members. Jack Rigsby volunteered to be on the committee. The other two committee members will be from the general membership at the next meeting.

A discussion about membership ensued. Mark proposed that members of AHS who want to be members of DSGA should have to pay a flat fee and be active in the club. There was no consensus on this issue.

It was suggested Dorothy and Mike Warren be made honorary members of DSGA. This was accepted by all present.
